The document should be typeset in the Times font (roman, bold, italic and bold italic) with Courier, Helvetica, Symbol and Zapf Dingbats fonts used if absolutely necessary.

The text should be 165 mm (6.5 in.) wide and 200 mm (8 in.) high with a 25.4 mm (1 in.) top, left and right margin.

The title should be typeset in 14 pt Times Bold, centred on the page, with uppercase letters, bold math symbols and lowercase letters used only where necessary in units and formulae. (In LaTeX  $2\varepsilon$  use the \Title{} command.) A footnote to the title, denoted by the 14 pt bold superscripted \* symbol, may be used to acknowledge financial support or other details. An extra 4 mm of vertical space should be inserted before the first set of authors.

The presenting author should be named first, underlined, and typeset in 12 pt Times Roman. (In LaTeX  $2_{\varepsilon}$  use the \presentingauthor{} command.) A footnote, denoted by the 12 pt superscripted  $\dagger$  symbol, may be used to show the author's e-mail address. Other authors from the same institution should follow on the same line, which should be centred. (In LaTeX  $2_{\varepsilon}$  use the \otherauthor{} command.) An extra 1 mm of vertical space should be inserted before the institution

The institution should be typeset in 12 pt Times Italic and centred. (In  $\LaTeX$  2 $\varepsilon$  use the \institution{} command.) An extra 3 mm of vertical space should be inserted before the next set of authors or the text.

Repeat the lists of authors and institutions as many times as necessary, observing the correct vertical spacing.

The text should be typeset in 10 pt Times Roman with a 5 mm (0.2 in.) indent at the beginning of each paragraph and an additional one-quarter line height spacing between paragraphs.

The abstract should not exceed one 200 mm (8 in.) high page.
